The Complete Mystery of God (Ken Walston – Kenna Outreach)

Shalom... Baruch Hashem, Adonai (Peace... Blessed be the name of the Lord God)

From Ken, who is an Elder in the Church, and who by Faith has been called by the Great God and Saviour, Jesus (*Yeshua*) the Messiah (*Adonai*), to be a Believer and Teacher for the edification of the Believers of the Way, the Church or Body of Messiah. May God the Father bring you Peace and Blessing according to <u>your Faith</u>...*Amen*.

To all of you who are in Christ Jesus, do you understand how blessed you really are? **Do you really understand that!**

The Lord Himself has given you a NEW Name, an Everlasting Name...one that will live forever in the Book of the Living. God Himself has written your name in His Book, the Book of the Living, and NO ONE, not even God will remove it. For the Lord Himself has given that promise to us and taken a vow unto His own Name and fulfilled the promise by sealing it with His own blood. Once you received Jesus the Messiah in your heart as your Lord and Saviour a supernatural transformation took place in the spirit realm immediately. In the Presence of the Almighty God, ALL of Heaven rejoiced because you came into the Kingdom of God by way of your Faith in Jesus the Messiah, and with that God the Father was glorified in the Highest. The Son, Jesus the Messiah, at that moment gave you a rebirth in the spirit and assigned you a NEW Name...and sitting at the Right Hand of the Father, He ordered His angel to scribe your name into the Lambs Book of the Living, and thus fulfilled the promise that "where I go, there also shall you be", and "we shall reign in the house of the Lord forever".

Now, the mystery in all of this is that even though we live in these bodies on earth and exist in this physical world, we also reside in spirit before the Lord. The Lord says that God cannot gaze upon sin and has no communion with the dead, yet even though our physical bodies have sin in them and the wages of that sin is death to our physical bodies, God has communion with us in the spirit through our rebirth with Jesus the Messiah and walks with us, and gazes upon us through the Blood of His Sacrifice and has made an Eternal Covenant with us through our Faith in Jesus the Messiah.

Why then does God plead with us not to sin. It is because we have inherited sin in our flesh and are first born into that. The flesh and the sin in the flesh is man's true nature and it is opposed to God and His nature, for God is Spirit and Eternal and has created man in His Own Image which is Spirit and Eternal, therefore every human being is truly made in the image of God by having imparted in them a Spirit which is Eternal

Now, the mystery in all of this is when the outer shell of the person (flesh) dies because of the inherited sin in it, the inner being (Spirit) will continue to live on in the realm of the Spirit (Eternal). If the person dies in their sin, meaning that they <u>did not</u> receive their Salvation and Eternal Life through <u>Jesus</u> the Messiah by <u>Faith</u>, then this Eternal Spirit goes to the grave (*the first death*) and waits for the day of God's Judgment. On that day, God will command their Spirit out of the grave

and they will stand before the Almighty and be Judged according to what they have done against the Eternal Standard that God had set forth through the Law. The Law was never meant to save anyone from their sin. It was given by God to show where man fell short of righteousness with God because of sin. God imposed the Law in order to give man a standard for guidance which points towards God's righteousness; but because the Law dealt with sin and its innate nature associated with the human heart, God Himself had to stand in proxy for man in order to reconcile man back to His Righteousness and Holy Presence.

Now, the mystery in all of this is that Jesus the Messiah was the physical evidence of the unseen God...that He was one with the Father (one in the same). That the unseen God (Eternal Spirit) had made Himself visible to His creation for the sole purpose of bringing them back unto Himself and forever transforming mankind from a state of sin, into a state of righteousness through <u>Faith</u> in Himself (Jesus the Messiah).

The power that God has given us is complete control of this flesh and the sins of the flesh through His Word (Jesus the Messiah), and our Faith in His Word. Remember, Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God. The Faith that I am speaking of is that which the Holy Spirit gives in truth through God's Spirit and we believe in it. It is not the faith that man acquires by his own understanding, experience and knowledge from the world through his flesh (self-sustaining mind and ego). Real and absolute truth comes through God's Spirit to our spirit because we have been given the Holy Spirit, who resides in us once we receive Jesus the Messiah, and the Holy Spirit reveals all the mystery of God and the secret truths, which come from God the Father. Therefore, what can we now say about all who have not received Jesus the Messiah ...that their means to receive and apply truth is not within them because their faith is not based on truth, but is based on what this physical world and their physical bodies can understand and apply in accordance with the five (5) physical senses and human logic.

Remember that God has an adversary in both the spirit and physical realm...in both the heavens and on earth. This adversary is <u>OUR</u> enemy and its agenda is to completely upset, confuse and destroy our <u>Faith</u> in <u>Jesus</u> the Messiah. Its purpose is to deceive, lie and give false testimony so that mankind will not believe in <u>Jesus</u> the Messiah and therefore rob mankind of their only means to salvation. <u>Jesus</u> called this adversary Satan (or in Hebrew "Abaddon"), which means "Destroyer". Satan has no love for God and had sworn vengeance against God and all of His creation especially against that which God had created in His Own Image...<u>Mankind</u>.

Now, the mystery in all of this is that God first created living beings within the environment of His Abode (Heaven), which is in the Spirit (Eternal). These beings had presence with the Almighty without restriction and innate characteristics of power and authority given as supernatural beings. Lucifer, whose name meant "Bringing Light", (later referred to by Jesus as Satan) was created at a supreme level as the Anointed Cherub. He was the one who guarded the Throne of God. He was revered as the most beautiful of the heavenly beings. Embedded within his being were musical instruments, which gave sounds that were pleasing to God and which gave great praise to the Almighty with every move he made.

Now, the mystery in all of this is that none of the heavenly beings that God had created were created in His Own Image...they were all free spirits who served God through His purpose. Even though God created Lucifer with great beauty, status and purpose, and set him above the highest order amongst the heavenly hosts, Lucifer had an internal desire to aspire beyond his created status and to become like God... even to the extent of overthrowing God's Throne. As his desires became more and more intense and perverted, his created purpose became opposed to

the Will in which God had created him for. Deep in Lucifer's being was a prideful arrogance and disobedience, which motivated him into rebellion against God. His great status and selfreverence inspired others of the heavenly hosts to side in with his desires which corrupted one third of all the angels and motivated them to stand with him in rebelling against God. The Lord God cast Lucifer and the rebellion of angels out of the Highest Heaven (away from the Presence of The Almighty and His Abode) and into an inner sanctuary of darkness which would later become the physical universe. Lucifer had now become the Adversary of God and stripped of his place and status with God and His Abode. As the Lord God cast Lucifer out of His Presence, He also transformed his being and all of the angels who followed him, into dark and deformed creatures of demonic order. With this came a metamorphosis of their spirit being and their names. Each were opposed to the righteous and holiness of God and His Order and each possessed a unique demonic identity and insurgent power. As they changed from Light into creatures of darkness, a shroud of deception and lies became their ambiance. Their witness was to defame and insult the Lord God and the Holiness of His Abode...to curse His Name and all of the Heavenly Hosts. They could never again turn back to God, nor go back to God or be restored to God...their fate was sealed in Eternal Damnation and their final Eternal Destination, the Lake of Fire.

Now, the mystery in all of this is that since the Lord God had created all of the heavens and physical universe out of Himself, He could not simply destroy and send it into oblivion when He found displeasure in it. There is an order to what God has commanded forth, and a Holiness which is revered to Himself through it. Because God the Father is Eternal in all things. He has vision into what He will set forth in the future, this coincides with His Will... the Lord says, "Nothing returns to Me void, all things are fulfilled". This demonstrates His complete Sovereign Power and Authority over everything in Heaven, the physical universe, and on Earth (including, the Under World). God set into existence His Creation through His Word, in a Command which is still going forth to this day. All things were created through Him (The Word), and not one thing in all of creation was created without Him (The Word). The Word is of course, the Word of God (Jesus the Messiah). When God determined man's existence, He did so with the compassion and love as a Father would towards His children. We (human beings) were created in His image, for God said to us that "you are god's". Through man, God had personification and communion with His creation through Himself. Where the angels and the Hosts of Heaven proclaim "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord", only man proclaims "Father, you are Holy!". This distinct difference is what enraged Satan and the powers of darkness to set a course of vengeance towards mankind in order to defeat and humiliate God with what He now called His children. When the Lord God created Lucifer, He did so as a servant but when the Lord God created Adam. He did so as a son. Adam was created by God's own hand from the dust (ground material) of the Earth. God molded his form into an image that would appear as God in the Flesh. Then the Lord God breathed his Life-Giving breath into the man and he became a Living Being. Unlike the angels and Hosts of Heaven who appeared out of nothing as shafts of light and sound to begin their endless worship and praise, man was set apart at the next highest order, to one day sit at the Right Hand of God the Son (Jesus the Messiah), and rule over the nations of the Earth and be the judge of the Heavenly Hosts.

Now, the mystery in all of this is that God gave all of His creation a free and willful character. He gave all of His creation the ability of <u>choice</u>. God set before His creation the knowledge and value of Good and Evil. When rebellion broke out in Heaven, God judged according to the knowledge and value of Good and Evil with the Heavenly Hosts, and His judgment determined the Everlasting outcome of creation in that realm. With that judgment came a new order for all who rebelled and for all who were Faithful unto God, as well as a separation of the knowledge

and value of Good and Evil. God Himself has chosen the balance for creation to be set with the knowledge and value of Good and Evil, yet in the Heavenly Abode of God, He has chosen to preponderate His own Nature and Will towards only Good. The value of Good in the nature of God is Eternal and Everlasting and shown to His creation in the virtues of Love, Mercy, Forgiveness, Peace and Grace which He expresses in ways that far exceed our human understanding or ability to express in such abundance as God is able to produce. The very essence and nature of God expresses these virtues so greatly that none other can be conceived nor portrayed by God Himself.

Now, the mystery in all of this is why has God chosen to expose man and the physical creation to the knowledge and value of Good and Evil in the first place...Why didn't God just place mankind in a perfect "Good" environment from conception? The dark void that God cast Satan into after his rebellion was the expanse of the physical universe before God had commanded Light and His Presence to appear. Everything was without form or substance, it was a holding place for the angelic beings who had defied God...a curtain between that which God sanctified (Good) and rejected (Evil). God created the physical universe as an expression of His Abode but reflective of the knowledge and value of Good and Evil, and in an environment where both Good and Evil could exist and the Perfect Will of God could be demonstrated. Therefore, the physical universe would have and contain the knowledge, value and substance of Good and Evil in every aspect of its creation. Thus the Lord God said "Let there be Light" and all things physical in this universe began their creation. As part of the command in which God had set forth through the Word in creating the physical universe, came a displacement of Eternal substance into physical matter and energy. The Abode of Heaven where God reigns is Eternal (no beginning and no end) and Everlasting (perpetual in existence and no decay of substance), where as in the physical universe God has chosen to divide the Eternal and Everlasting into phases and segments called "Time". He has chosen to regulate the phases and segments by equal intervals of calculated measure He called "Days". Nothing in the Abode of God (Heaven) has any measure of time which is relative to the physical universe and its creation...as the Lord God says in reference to our existence here on Earth verses the equivalent measure as viewed in the Eyes of God in His Abode, "a thousand years is but a twinkling of the eye".

Now, the mystery in all of this is that the Lord God had chosen a central point in the physical universe to measure time, in both a "Coming and Going" and "Point to Point" relationship. When the Lord God referenced "In the beginning, God created the heavens and the Earth", He was making a distinct identity between all things created in the physical universe (heavens) and a unique place within it (Earth). The Earth was formed as the central point where the Lord God would establish His physical presence in the universe and through His Virtue allow physical life to sustain itself. Therefore, God had proclaimed the Earth to be an extension of His Abode, and in plain view of the powers of darkness, who had been cast into the expanse of the physical universe. He announced the Earth to be His Footstool. The imagery being portrayed, is as the Lord God sits on His Throne in Heaven (Eternal), His Majesty (Dominance) extends to the physical creation through the Earth. About this the Lord God has said, "on the Day of Judgment no one will be able to say that they did not know the existence of God, for nature itself proclaims God's existence, and the Earth is proof of His handy-work". The absolute proclamation that the Lord God was making is that ALL physical life, the existence of life, and the Communion between God and the physical creation would be bound to this one central point within the entire physical universe...the Earth.

In the Divine Will of God, He commanded creation into existence, He also established the Order associated to sustaining the substance of matter and energy outside the Abode of Heaven and

His Physical Presence (Eternal and Everlasting). This Order was given to creation in the form of physical laws we call Physics. The laws of physics apply themselves consistently throughout the physical universe and are proven by means of science. Science is the human interpretation of what man can deduce of the physical universe through applied and systematized knowledge. It uses what God has provided in the form of substance (matter and energy) and divides it into equitable conditions and conclusions based on scientific theory and physical evidence.

Now, the mystery in all of this is that what is unseen (God), has created all which can be seen (physical universe), and that man can only prove the existence of what can be seen through science, yet God is above everything in both existence and form and can only be accessed and recognized by man through Faith. God is motivated by our Faith without doubt!
When the Lord God created all things, He did so with His Word through a Command of Faith without any doubt, meaning that His Desire and His Will were set on one and the same thing, thus the Command was Faithful in both execution and fulfillment.

Why is *Doubt* such an important factor in relationship to <u>Faith</u>. . . Because the Order in which God has commanded the evidence of everything into being is through <u>Faith</u>. Quite simply, in the Eyes of God, *Doubt* is sin and in the Presence of God it is separation. It is the opposite of <u>Faith</u> and in opposition to the Nature and Will of God. *Doubt* opposes any action which is motivated by <u>Faith</u>, and in the realm of the physical world has an influence of a demonic spirit which denies and dilutes what <u>Faith</u> is calling forth. *Doubt* causes any request from the heart or desire for fulfillment to wait upon conditions which are satisfied either to physical laws or human understanding....it does not allow the request or desire to move into the realm of the unseen or supernatural (Spirit) where God exists and is motivated in exercising His Power and Authority. God is motivated by <u>Faith</u>, and <u>Faith</u> alone...this is the Divine Will of God!

Therefore, I charge you by the Name, which is above ALL names (Jesus the Messiah), to request ALL things, every desire from your heart which is set on goodness, to be exercised in Faith which has no doubt, and to be steadfast, standing upon this Faith as a sure foundation. To call upon the Name of the Lord when *doubt* starts to set in and the enemy of God comes against you. Remind the Lord of His promise (for God is not a liar and keeps His promises), that everything we ask for in His Name under agreement (in Faith without doubt) SHALL be given to us in order to glorify God the Father... Amen! Be as relentless in not giving up as our enemy is... for the devil (Satan) who is spirit (part of the unseen) has great power and authority in this world (the realm of the physical universe), and knows that he has but a short time left. The Lord God had originally given this power to Man (Adam) but Adam fell into sin though his disobedience by not fulfilling the Command of God, which was for him to restrain from taking of the fruit from the Tree of Knowledge of 'Good and Evil'. At this time in man's existence he was sinless in the Eyes of God and had been given ALL authority over the entire physical universe which was stationed for him on the Earth. Adam was commanded by God to subdue the Earth and all things within it. Satan and the angelic hosts (who had been cast out of the Presence of God), were loose but in bondage within the void of the physical universe. When God created the control point for the physical universe where He would establish His Presence in it (the Earth), Satan and his hordes made a bee-line to where that action was taking place. The powers of darkness had existence in the void for an uncalculated amount of time before the Lord God set His Presence in Light upon the dark void and moved over the face of the waters of planet Earth. It was a beacon for the demonic beings to gravitate towards. As God fulfilled His purpose in creating the Earth, and the abode above it, the powers of darkness hid in the void of darkness around the Earth until the Lord God had finished his work. Then Satan in all of his arrogance and defiance made his

presence upon the Earth but did not understand the meaning of God's purpose behind it. He was deceived in understanding the similarity that God had made between Heaven and the area called Paradise. He did not understand the purpose nor the meaning of the physical sun and the moon nor the billions of stars and lights in the sky; but when he saw Man (Adam), he knew exactly who he was and he felt the Presence of the Lord God through the Man. The powers of darkness were unable to touch or disrupt the course in which God was taking the Man. God had given all of His Sovereign Authority to the Man within the physical universe and was preparing the Man to rule in His behalf. Before Lucifer was cast out of Heaven, he had gazed upon the Heart of God and saw what the Lord God had in way of the future, in line with His Will. He saw Man being created and the image of Man sitting at the Right Hand of the Power of God the Father. He knew that this creation would be above him and would rule over him for Eternity. So, in his defiance towards God, Satan would scheme a way to put a wedge between God and His Creation. He already knew from experience that disobedience is the highest order of rejection by God.

Now, the mystery in all of this is that the Lord God would allow Satan to oppose the Man and scheme a way to deceive him. Adam had no practical knowledge of 'Good and Evil'. He did not have the concept that these were forces opposed to each other, that one is the adversary of God and the other is the very Nature of God. From the moment Adam became physically alive, he was spiritually conscience of the full identity and purpose of God as the Creator. Adam gazed upon the Presence of the Lord God and was in full communion with the Lord God, one on one. Even so. Adam was made from the dust (material) of the Earth, and was not eternal in his physical attire. What Adam reflected was the image of God in the Flesh...there was no other creature like Man in all of creation. He was created as body (physical), soul (mind or consciousness) and spirit (eternal image of God). His body (flesh) had an innate character of sin in it because it was made from the physical Earth. The flesh sin had not been activated in the man until he disobeyed the Command of God. When Adam obtained the knowledge of 'Good and Evil', the sin in his flesh became activated and his entire physical being became corrupted by that knowledge because he had put into action what he had learned. The Man had separated himself from the pureness of what God had purposed for him and enlightened in the knowledge and ways of sin. Thus, when the Man sinned against God, the Lord God decreed "that the wages of sin is death", and the Man began to die from that moment forward.

God retracted His authority from Man to rule in the Eternal (Spirit) on Earth. He had lost the power and authority of subduing the earth and all that was within it from the Eternal (Spirit) sense but not from the physical perspective. Man had given that authority and power over to the powers of darkness when Satan had cloaked himself in the shroud of an animal (a serpent) to deceive the woman (Eve), who in turn deceived the Man (Adam) by tempting him to disobey the Command of God. It was not until the Man had committed the act of disobedience that God passed His Judgment on Mankind. His Judgment would include cursing the Earth as a resource against the Man, making toil a virtuous necessity in Man's daily existence for survival, until he would return back to the ground in which he came from. In the woman His Judgment would be a physical curse, increasing her trouble in pregnancy and increasing her pain in childbirth, yet in spite of this she would maintain a compelling desire for her husband (sexually and emotionally) and she would be subject to his authority and control (Master over her). Then the Lord God cast them out of the Garden, which He called Paradise, to the outskirts of the Earth where the natural forces of nature and the powers of darkness were waiting. From this venue Man began his struggle of life and the sentencing of death, which would follow all mankind because Man had become sin and imposed God's Judgment upon the physical creation...this would become the legacy of Man's disobedience. The Lord God would maintain His communion with Man through

prayer and supplication but would no longer allow Man to look upon His face...God would mysteriously distance Himself.

When the Lord God set everything into existence, the auxiliary of Heaven was opened to creatures of worship and praise, and in the midst of the "Fire" of God was Himself, in the form of a Physical Being. This image was a mystery to all of the Hosts of Heaven until the Lord God revealed Himself on Earth as the man-child (Jesus the Messiah) in a stable in Bethlehem, Israel ~2000 years ago. Until Jesus the Messiah was born, all of the human creation was bound by God's Judgment against sin. Out of the Wilderness of Wondering, God brought forth a Nation of His own Chosen People (Israel) in which He would bring forth the supplications of the Law (Torah) and the warnings and directions of the Prophets. The Law (Law of Moses) was the standard by which God revealed His displeasure with Man's sinful condition and would be a constant reminder of the wedge that Man had made between spirit and flesh. The Prophets revealed action (present and future) that God would fulfill if Man remained in disobedience against the Will of God. The Law produced a Covenant between God and Man's sinful nature by imposing ritualistic events for man to do in order to appease God's Wrath and Judgment. As the Jews continued to stagger from the path of Righteousness under the conditions of the Covenant established by the Law, the Lord God would reveal the purpose of His Will through the Prophets. As the Lord God established the nation of Israel under a Covenant by the Law, He was pronouncing His intention to all of the human creation for future reconciliation of their sinful condition.

Now, the mystery in all of this is that God would first reconcile a nation under a Covenant by the Law, and that this Covenant would be the foundation for all of the human creation to follow, until which time God would complete His reconciliation with Man by the act of His own personal sanctification, through the Blood Sacrifice of His only Begotten Son, Jesus the Messiah, and release Mankind from their bondage of sin and His Judgment against all flesh...thus the wages of sin (death) would be deposed and replaced by Salvation through Propitiation and the Clemency of God. In doing so, Israel would become personally connected to the Will of the Father (God Himself), and take on a personage with God, that set them apart from the rest of the human creation by being called the Children of Israel or the Children of God. This implied that God was their Father, and that the image of The Father would be pronounced in every edict of their society and religion and would make them unique amongst all mankind. Because of this, the restraints against the Children of Israel were severe. The Law, in and of itself, imposed conditions which would require Israel to isolate themselves from the rest of the world. God had dictated a strict ritual purity in order to fulfill a physical sanctification and allow a chosen representative of the nation to stand in proxy for the whole nation before the Presence of God. This representative was the High Priest. He would be giving Offerings and Sacrifices unto the Lord God in accordance with the prescribed methods outlined by God through the Law of Moses. All of the Imagery, Symbolism and Ritual of the High Priest pointed to the future representative (Jesus the Messiah), who would stand in proxy for all mankind before the Presence of the Almighty God, to be the High Priest of the Temple of God in Heaven and the Eternal Sin Offering, which would appease God's Wrath and Judgment forever. Jesus the Messiah proclaimed that, "those who believe in Me shall never die but have Eternal Life ", and He further proclaimed, "I AM the Way, the Truth, and the Life, No one goes to The FATHER except through Me".

Now, the mystery in all of this is that four thousand years prior to the coming of Jesus the Messiah, since the day Man was cast out of the Garden where God's physical Presence was, Adam and his seed (offspring – *Mankind*) were under the Sentencing of Death because of sin.

Two thousand years prior to the coming of Jesus the Messiah, since the day that Abraham (*Avraham*) left his father's house in Ur, God created the nation of His people, and proclaimed to them a Promise and gave the vision of a Promised Land, which would bring forth the birth and offspring of His Salvation for Mankind.

One thousand eight hundred years prior to the coming of Jesus the Messiah, since the day Jacob (*Ya'akov* - grandson of Abraham) would receive from God the transformation of his name to *Israel (Yisrael)* meaning '*God Struggles*', which identified him to the Everlasting Covenant that God promised to Abraham for the nation and produced twelve sons who would become the ancestors of the twelve tribes of Israel. That from Judah (*Y'hudah*) in Bethlehem (*Beit-Lechem*), God would establish the lineage to the Messiah (Jesus the Saviour).

One thousand two hundred and fifty years prior to the coming of Jesus the Messiah, since the day Moses (*Moshe*) led the nation of His people out of Egypt in the Exodus, God transformed the nation, into representatives on Earth who would receive from Heaven what God had perfected in His Righteousness for sinful Man to live by...which was the Law (*Torah*). That God would establish His Tabernacle (*Dwelling House*) in the midst of the nation of His people, to perfect their worship and obedience under the first Covenant ordained by the Law.

One thousand years prior to the coming of Jesus the Messiah, since the day God proclaimed Saul (*Sha'ul*) as the first King of Israel and established the nation of His people as a kingdom on Earth...that God would proclaim and anoint a new King (*David*), out of a sheep pasture as a young boy from Judah in Bethlehem (*Beit-Lechem*), and that he would be the heir to the House of Israel and the lineage to the seed of Messiah. That from the House of David would come the next King and heir (*Solomon-Shlomo*) to build the Holy Temple (*House of God*), and proclaimed that God had established permanence on Earth with the nation of His people, in the city of Jerusalem (*Yerushalayim*). That this place would forever be called the Holy City of God, and be the place where God would proclaim His Salvation and sanctify all of the world.

One year prior to the coming of Jesus the Messiah, the prophecies that had foretold His birth and the setting of events that would verify His arrival as the Messiah were being fulfilled. A virgin chosen by God and the man whom she was to marry, who was from the House of David born in Bethlehem (*Beit-Lechem*), were to be the earthly parents of the Son of God. As God the Father, bestowed His Spirit, the woman conceived in Holiness a child that would have no sin...neither in body (*flesh*) nor soul (*mind*). That through her husband, the child would have the human lineage of the House of David bestowed to Him as well...thus fulfilling the prophecy that the Messiah would be born of a virgin to the House of David.

Now, the mystery in all of this is that the coming of Jesus the Messiah marked the beginning of the fulfillment to God's promise for all Mankind...that their sins would be forgiven as well as forgotten...that the sting of death would no longer be a bondage to life, and that the Heart of God was going to be demonstrated to ALL of Mankind as Mercy. The nature of God is Love. The Lord said of Himself that "God is Love". Jesus the Messiah sealed the New Covenant of God with His Love, "for God so loved the world, that He gave His Only Begotten Son, so that everyone who believes in Him shall not perish but have Everlasting Life". What God gave became the Sacrifice of His Body and Blood..."the Blood of the New Covenant", and with a new commandment, He set forth the order of what He called His Church..."that you love one another as I have loved you" and "too love your neighbour as you love yourself, for in this resides the entire Law".

To all my dear Brethren and those who are unsaved, through Jesus the Messiah, God was no longer demanding that Man carry out the act of a ritual, by making a sacrifice under the Law in order to redeem a nation for a period of time; but rather, He was now offering Himself as the Sacrifice which released All Mankind from the burden of their sin, which demanded the Law to be imposed. Therefore, we are no longer under the Law but through the Blood of the New Covenant of Jesus the Messiah, we have been rescued from the Wrath and Judgment of God and the Second Death. The First Death is the result of God's judgment against sin being engulfed in the body (flesh) of every human being. God has pronounced death as the result of sin in both the body and human spirit...the body goes to the grave and returns to the natural elements of the Earth, while the Eternal Spirit of the person waits in the darkness of the grave for the Day of Judgment. The Second Death is God's Judgment against the spirit of each and every human ever born into existence who opposed the New Covenant (this is called the Great White Throne Judgment). It must be made very clear that in the Eyes of God, existence (Life) begins at the moment of conception in the womb. As the Lord God has mentioned in His Written Word (the Holy Bible) and the Testimony of His Prophets, "I knew you in the womb" and "from your seed shall I multiple a nation which cannot be counted in number amongst the stars". It is evident that at the moment a man impregnates a woman with his seed, that through this act, God has commanded Life to begin and holds it accountable unto Himself. Nevertheless, every human being conceived is done so into the innate character of Man's sin and will possess the sin nature from conception.

The outcome of God's Judgment of a person's Eternal Spirit into Damnation is the Second Death, for all who are found guilty of disobedience and rejection towards God's New Covenant through Jesus the Messiah, and whose names are not found in the Book of the Living, shall be cast into the Lake of Fire...which is the Second Death!

The Lake of Fire is an Eternal place where the Lord God will impose His Eternal Judgment and incarcerate sin forever. This is the Justice of God and is not negotiable between Himself and His Creation. It was intended for Satan and his fallen angels; but will be the destination of every human being whose heartfelt opposition and disobedience was against the Word of God and His Salvation (Jesus the Messiah). The Lake of Fire is a place of Eternal Separation and Torment, where the person feels the pain and burning associated with fire, where gnashing of teeth and screaming is prevalent, and utter agony prevails, yet the Fire does not consume the person ...as the Lord God has stated, "anyone whose name was not found in the Book of the Living, was thrown into the Lake of Fire, and the smoke of their torment shall go up forever and ever without end".

Now, the mystery in all of this is that the Lake of Fire exists in a chasm, separated far below the New Heavens and the New Earth (Book of Revelation, Chapter 21). It is like an ocean with no end to its horizon. Churning molten action, which gives the appearance of flames. The substance of the Fire is actually spiritual, and not substance of matter and energy as we know it in the physical universe. The Fire is the Love of God in its purity of Substance and Spirit. As the Lord says, "My Love is as a burning fire which consumes all that stands before it". In this the Lord is identifying His Being as all-consuming to the Creation, and He has complete Power and Authority over everything which stands before Him. God has created everything from Himself, the Nature and Presence of God is in everything, therefore, everything has the Nature of God in it. This means that God's Love is prevalent in everything He has created, in Heaven and on Earth (the Physical Universe). When the Lord God calls up the Creation to Final Judgment and separates the wheat from the chaff, He will be separating Himself from the Chaff (sin) and those who will be identified as sin. At the moment He passes Final Judgment and Commands the

unrighteous to be cast into the Lake of Fire, a metamorphous is completed in the spirit of these people. The innate Love of God is removed from their being forever and they become complete and total sin. They share the same outcome as Satan and the demonic beings who rejected the Love of God and were sentenced to Eternal Damnation. At this point God must turn His face away from them and their punishment, for the Lord has said, "I cannot gaze upon their sin, nor will they stand in my Presence...I have forsaken the evil thing and have no communion with them". In being totally opposite of the Nature and Will of God, these people and creatures now are tormented when thrown into the Lake of Fire, which is the purity and substance of the Love of God. It burns them in torment as the Love of God rejects the sin, which is incarcerated (incarnate) into their very beings forever.

My dear Brethren, there is nothing which has been written in this letter that is untrue or false. The Holy Spirit of God has inspired and enlightened every word of it. As I send it out to the Church (Body of Messiah) throughout the world, I am reminded by the Lord God, that there is very little time left before the things which have been written and told about regarding the End Times of the Last Days all come to pass. God's Love and Mercy surpasses all understanding and is still going forth for ALL mankind to receive through (Jesus the Messiah); but His Judgment is coming soon, and it will be swift and complete, and everlasting. The time is near for the return of Jesus the Messiah...for His Second Coming (the Rapture), which is for the Church..." for the Lord Himself shall descend out of Heaven and in a shout (Command), with the Trump of God and the voice of the Archangel; and the dead in Messiah shall rise to life first and ascend unto the Lord in the Clouds; then we who are alive at that moment shall be changed, from mortal into immortal, and shall meet them in the air, into the cloud, and we shall always and forever be with the Lord". Then what will follow will be the Greatest Tribulation against Man and this world, the likes of which has never been seen before, since the beginning of all Creation. God's Wrath shall fall on this world and unto ALL mankind for seven (7) years. He will pour out the Bowls and Cups of His Wrath on the Earth and make All of Mankind weep in bitter anguish. As for those who were part of the Body of Messiah, we are in the Presence of the Lord God in Heaven, partaking in the Marriage Feast of the Lamb. After the Lord calls the Church (Past and Present) unto Himself, we are being prepared to be presented by the Son (Jesus the Messiah) to the Father (Adonai) as His Bride...the Church becomes the Bride of Messiah and is presented as a gift to the Father forever. We sit at the Right Side of Messiah, and He sits at the Right Hand of the Power of God, the Father (Adonai).

Now, the mystery in all of this is that before the Lord God can end the physical Dispensation of Time, and allow the preponderance of His own Nature and Will towards only 'Good' to triumph over the powers of darkness and the knowledge and value of Evil; He must allow Evil to accentuate beyond the purpose He had intended it for.

When the final battle against good and evil is fought, it is fought both in the heavenly realm (spirit) and the physical (flesh). It begins with Man against Man, but in the end, Satan once again tries to win and triumph over God by putting forth a last strong attempt to fight it out with the Heavenly Hosts. In his deception, he rallies all of the demonic forces against Man and against the spirits in the atmosphere of Earth. In his final attempt, he curses and blasphemes the name of the Lord God and all the Heavenly Hosts in the highest order possible...then claims to be God in the physical and sits in the Holy Place of the new Temple in Jerusalem as the Messiah incarnate; this is known as the "Abomination of Desolation". He makes all of mankind worship him as their god by having a mandatory requirement that no one can buy or sell any product or conduct any business or work, unless they have his mark (the mark of his name) placed on either their forehead or right hand...this will be known as "the Mark of the Beast". In preparation for this,

God has brought a great deception upon both spirit and flesh to where they both act in one accord. The Lord said that, "in the Last Days, the Father will send a spirit of deception to all Mankind...and if He did not shorten those days, even the elite (Body of Messiah) would falter and fall under its control". This will be a spiritual wave of demonic force that has been held back since the foundations of the world were created, that God the Father will command to be let loose...this sets the premise for the Anti-Christ to subdue the earth and all mankind with the power of this great deception, to take the Mark of the Beast and believe that he is God.

The horror that will be revealed on the Great and Terrible Day of the Lord, is when Jesus the Messiah is sitting on the Judgment Seat of God and commands the Angel of the Lord to throw these people into the Lake of Fire. The Lord God, in His Divine and Holy Nature, is not only Love...but Justice as well. The Mercy of God towards the righteous demands fulfillment of His Justice. In order for the fulfillment of ALL things to pass from sin into righteousness, under the allotted Dispensation of Time that God the Father has given within this physical realm, He must pass Judgment on all unrighteousness and cast it into the Lake of Fire, where it will be completely separated from His Presence forever. After this is completed, then the Lord God will resend His command of the Physical Creation, which has been going forth since the beginning of all creation, and all of the universe (physical heavens and Earth), will burn up and melt from intense heat, and with great noise, and be completely destroyed. The Lord God will put forth an Everlasting Command for a New Heavens and New Earth to be created, and from the Abode of God in Heaven, the Lord will restore the City of Jerusalem on the New Earth. It will be the City of God where Man will dwell forever and ever... Amen.

My dear Brethren, in your reading of this, I charge you in the Name of the Most High God, Jesus the Messiah, to heed what has been written in this letter, for the Lord Himself has given utterance of these words and has directed me through His Spirit to write them down and send it to <u>ALL</u> of the Body of Messiah (*the Church*) throughout the entire world.

"If you have ears, then listen to what the Spirit is saying! Even so, come Lord Jesus!"
