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Does God Say, “Thank You”? (Ken Walston – Kenna Outreach Ministries)

From Ken, who is an Elder in the Church and by Faith proclaims this message to be one of truth and acknowledgement from the Spirit of ADONAI and is revealed as such for His Purpose. It must be recognized that only through a spirit of humility and heartfelt worship and servitude does God honour our request to serve Him. ADONAI has again given to His imperfect servant insight regarding the mystery of God. As it is being given, may it be received.

The concise answer to whether God says “Thank You” is **NO!** The asking for or needing to express gratitude to His Creation in any form would mean that He is subservient to that which He has Created and has Rule Over. He is the Eternal King and above all things in heaven and this physical creation (universe) which includes the earth where he has established all life from. God is Spirit (Ruach) and He is Holy (Kadosh), thus He is Omnipotent (All Powerful without restrictions in using His Power) and Benevolent (Perfect in all manner of Being) and He is Omnipresent (Everywhere in the physical universe and in Heaven at the same time, there is no space that He does not occupy). Because He is The Holy Being, He answers to no other spirits or physical beings under His Creation. Everything bows down to Him and declares that He is Lord and God. Everything and everyone gives Him thanks for being “The Most High God” declaring, Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord God Almighty! (El Shaddai) Isaiah 6:3, Revelation 4:8

In order to Love Him, we are to Worship Him and keep His Commandments in our hearts and spirit and in our minds at all times, placing Him Above All Things in our worship of Him.

We show respect and honour to one another as fellow human beings in our living here on earth by saying Thank You to each other and honouring Good Deeds by expressing a show of thanks. That’s because we are equal amongst each other as a species, and even though we may rule over and interact with each other in some form or another with authority (i.e.: Sovereignty, Governments, Employers, Parents, Personal Relationships, etc.), we are still part of God’s Creation and He has dominance over all of us and we are subject to the guidance and laws which He has imposed for us to live by, whether we realize or accept it, His Rule, His Prominence engages us because He Wills it to be so, we are the ones who are subject to Him, not Him to us.

There is one thing that God desires and demands of us, our love and worship of Him. From the Original Aramaic Text (Brit HaChadashah) Yeshua Adonai states in the Gospel of Matthew 22:37-38, ***“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment.”*** He was expounding on the First of the Ten Commandments given to Moses (*Moshe*) by God on Mount Sinai where the Lord God was making it quite clear to the nation of Israel, and through them to all of the world (Humanity), that He was the One True God and Sovereign Lord, and that He was the only one to be worshiped and no other. From the Original Hebrew Text (TANAKH) it says in Exodus 20:3-5, ***“You shall have no other gods besides Me. You shall not make for yourself a sculptured image, or any likeness of what is in the heavens above, or on the earth below, or in the waters under the earth. You shall not bow down to them or serve them. For I the Lord your God am an impassioned (Jealous) God...”***

Why all the fuss about worship and having no other reference point of worship for anything else? It undeniably without question or debate gives acknowledgement to His Sovereignty, Lordship and Holiness. That He is the Creator of all things and no one else. In the Abode of God, everything is constantly worshiping Him, calling out in the billions and billions of angelic beings with loud and thunderous voices, ***“Glory, Glory, Glory be unto the Lord God Almighty, Praise unto Him Who sits on the Throne. Glory and Honor and Praise and Worship to the One True God, Who Is and Who Was, Who Lives Forever.”*** This has been going on in Heaven since before time began, before the foundations of the earth and universe were formed, for eons. The very moment that these angelic hosts appeared out of nothing as fiery beings screaming into their existence praising God in the Highest, and it shall never cease.

Likewise, with His Highest Order of Creation on earth, that which was created from His Own Image and meant to stand in His Presence forever, that we shall have no less recourse than the angelic beings which stand before Him constantly, to also worship in the same manner, the One True God (*YAHWEH*). As the physical representative of God in the flesh, Yeshua Adonai (Jesus the Christ) showed us how to give thanks. He did not honour or praise or worship any part of the creation but instead gave all thanks unto His Father (YaHaWah) who was in Heaven. Giving us the guideline by which to pray, He started by honouring the Father's Name, and pronouncing His Will to be done, then requesting His Blessing and asking for His Righteous Protection and Restraint. And so, therefore we are to give thanks unto God for all things given and taken from Him and He is to be Worshiped and Glorified by us through Faith, which has no doubt...our true expression of Love and Admiration in thanking Him (Toda Raba ADONAI) for all things.
